## The Dance Conservatory.


We would like to take the time to remind our families of our COVID Protocols as well as inform the new students who have just joined us. Like every new year the opening of a new season is always so hectic and registrations are ongoing for the first month and it takes time to settle everyone into the new season. It is very important that we all do our part in keeping us all safe. That includes all the students, staff and families. Each of us bring a different bubble into the studio so it is imperative we take the precautions to keep those bubbles separated.

Please follow the following guidelines.

1. Students must enter through the front of the building and exit through the back.



2. Masks must be worn at all times in the building and in dance classes.



3. Students must sanitize their hands upon entering the building and again when they leave to go home.



4. Each student must have their temperature taken before their class begins. Temperatures will be taken before their first class by an assigned teacher or administrator. An itemized schedule will be posted outside each studio.



5. Students are to go into the lounge no more than two or three at a time to put their outside belongings away and then must take their dance belongings and valuables into the studio in their white bins. No outdoor shoes or clothing permitted in the studios.



6. Students must remain 6 feet apart at all times in class and in the studios. This applies to sitting in the lounge and foyer when on a break from class.



7. No one are to be in the hallways except to access their classes, the office and the washroom.



8. Students must sanitize the barres after each ballet class if another group of students are using the space next. Wherever possible we are keeping the students in the same studio and moving the teachers. Due to class sizes some times this may not be the case so an in-between cleaning is required. Students are also responsible to disinfect the equipment used in conditioning classes.




9. Teachers will spray medical grade disinfectant after the last classes each night.



10. Students will be allotted a specific space for their breaks where they can safely social distance and will be encouraged to go outside, weather permitting, for fresh air. If the space is limited inside, a mask must be worn.



11. Students are to stay home if they are sick or show symptoms. If able they are encouraged to take their classes via zoom until they are healthy to return to class.
